## The 100<sup>th</sup> Isle of Man midnight race.

### Provisional Notice of Race

In association with RORC, ISORA and DBYC the 100<sup>th</sup> running of the Isle of Man midnight race will take place on Friday, 5<sup>th</sup> of July 2019.

The start time is to be determined, but HW Liverpool is 13:52 BST 9.2m

The Race will have two courses, one around 75Nm, and an additional 30 miles to enable those competitors requiring RORC qualification distance for Fastnet or other World Sailing OSR Class 1 or 2 events. It is likely that the Lyver Trophy will be awarded to the winner of the qualification distance race.

In conjunction with ISORA, IRC and RYA/NHC competitors are expected to enter both the LYC/TSC and ISORA classifications.

RYA NHC (National Handicap for Cruisers) and is similar to ISF Echo. Don't have an IRC certificate?, but want to take part, then NHC is for you assuming your boat is on the RYA base list. If its not let us know early enough and we will get a NHC handicap rating.

LYC/TSC will also encourage vessels either sail or powered to cruise in company with the race. We hope that such vessels will wish to joining the social, they will not be required to enter ISORA classification.
